Liquid foundation is great for anyone with skin imperfections like blemishes or hyperpigmentation that they'd like to conceal quickly and easily. It's great for beginners to the world of foundation, and it can be used in conjunction with other products, like concealer and powder, to create a flawless base for the rest of your makeup.Q. (We love to use a damp Beauty Blender for sponge applications.) In a hurry? Blend on your foundation using a circular buffing motion with a large foundation brush to save some time.Q. Selecting a foundation at Sephora is easy because of the testers, but do you have any tips for drugstore buys when you can't try them on?A. Selecting the right shade can certainly be tricky. Many people will tell you to hold the shade near your wrist in the store to evaluate the shade, but we disagree. Your wrist is often a different color than your facial skin. We recommend finding a mirror within the store and holding the bottle up to your face. It's the closest you'll get to using a tester!Q. I love liquid foundation when freshly applied, but it never lasts. How do I make my liquid foundation stay on longer?A. Always start with a primer underneath your liquid foundation and finish with setting powder to make sure it's locked in all day long. "A combination of properly prepping your skin and setting it will ensure a smoother application and wear time while using liquid foundations," says makeup artist Lauren Wolborsky. "How your makeup performs reflects your skin's health and hydration levels, so it's important to maintain your skin care while using liquid foundation for best results." After testing dozens of formulas, we've rounded up the top eight liquid foundations worth adding to your routine. So it's the perfect choice for both everyday wear and special occasions. Who It's For: Whether you're seeking a soft, natural look or a more polished finish, this foundation is versatile enough to get both with long-lasting results. Plus, it doesn't crease, cake, or settle into pores and fine lines. The foundation also offers SPF 25 sun protection. (Though, considering dermatologists recommend at least SPF 30, don't let it replace your daily sunscreen.) All in all: your skin will look like skin. Who It's For: Anyone who wants a natural, semi-matte finish from a foundation at a reasonable price point. If you struggle to find an exact match for your skin tone, the shade range is pretty extensive here. Our tester noted the coverage looks very natural and, at a midway point between radiant and soft matte, so it's great if you want your skin to look fresh but not dewy. Who It's For: If you want a foundation that looks great and helps protect your skin, here you go! We already loved that the foundation offers SPF, but knowing that it also helps hydrate and plump the skin is the real cherry on top. Our tester noted the shade selection is somewhat limited, but after the foundation dried, it seemed to match their skin tone better. Who It's For: Combination skin that's prone to acne or excess oil will love this foundation that works to keep skin clear while evening everything out and providing a clean, matte finish. This full-coverage formula helps control oil and minimizes the appearance of pores for a smooth, flawless complexion—our tester noted all their imperfections were covered with it. With SPF 15, the formula provides sun protection and a matte, full-coverage finish. Who It's For: We wouldn't suggest keeping on makeup for a full 24 hours, but if you have to, this is the foundation to use. It feels breathable on the skin. Plus, since the lightweight formula also provides some sun protection, it makes it great for a travel pick (or if you just tend to forget to put sunscreen on your face). The foundation does a good job at covering the minor and more noticeable imperfections on my face. My skin effectively appears more even with this product. The coverage looks like I have makeup on my face but is not heavy or cakey." "Some people may ask about primers and, sure, some primers help depending on your skin, but if you want your liquid foundation to not look cakey, focus on good skin care—it will look better and last longer," says celebrity makeup artist Emily Gray Higgins, who advises applying liquid foundation with either a dense foundation brush to help buff the product into the skin or a damp beauty blender for those with dry skin. To start, we researched and collected insights from dozens of tests, including best foundations for mature skin, acne-prone skin, as well as the best foundations with SPF. We evaluated each product on their coverage, feel, finish, and transfer resistance, paying special attention to the liquid foundations that outperformed in each of these categories. In the end, the products that left us especially impressed ended up on this page. Coverage: Liquid foundations come in a variety of coverages, ranging from light to full. You'll find that most foundations fall between medium and full coverage (with BB and CC creams offering lighter coverage), though there are some light options. What type of coverage you choose depends on your skin concerns as well as personal preferences. Do you want to cover large areas of redness or breakouts? You'll likely want a foundation that offers full coverage. Finish: Think about how you want your skin to look post-application. If you want to look dewy and glowing, consider a hydrating foundation with a satin finish. "Our skin acts like a sponge when it comes to skin care and liquid foundations and will soak up the hydrating benefits of your liquid foundation throughout the day (especially considering most liquid foundations are formulated with hydrating ingredients)," says Wolborsky. If you want a mattified end look, choose a matte foundation. Oilier skin types may prefer a matte finish to help combat that mid-morning shine, whereas drier types may want a dewier finish and hydrating formula from a foundation made specifically for dry skin. Wear: Do you want a long-lasting foundation that wears flawlessly all day? You'll want to buy a foundation that's designed to last for up to at least 12 hours, and that's specifically designed not to cake or crease. "Setting your liquid foundations is crucial to the longevity of your makeup. This step takes your complexion from a liquid/cream state to a smooth, transfer-resistant state," says Wolborsky. Using pressed powders is a great way to achieve this and will help your foundation last longer in the areas you apply it to. Both liquid and cream foundation can be great for mature skin, but most makeup artists prefer liquid foundation since it does a better job of sinking into the skin rather than sitting on top of it, which can highlight fine lines and wrinkles. "There are some liquid foundations with a dewy, hydrating finish, which would be wonderful for those with more mature skin, as mature skin tends to be thinner and drier. Hydration is going to be your best bet," says Gray. Liquid foundations infused with skin care ingredients are also beneficial to mature skin. Gray suggests looking for ingredients like hyaluronic acid, which is known for helping skin retain water and improving plumpness. "Liquid foundations that would not be the best for mature skin are those with fuller coverage and more matte finishes. What that says to me is that the foundation is not only a heavy feeling, but would further dry the skin out," she says. The best way to apply liquid foundation is largely subjective. Some people prefer to apply their foundation with their fingertips, while others find better success with a foundation brush or makeup sponge. While most makeup artists recommend using a brush or sponge, both because of the smooth, even results you can achieve and the fact that it's more hygienic (as long as you clean your makeup brushes, that is), Wolborsky suggests using a damp beauty sponge to achieve lighter coverage or help "sheer out your more full-coverage foundations." If you prefer to use a makeup brush, the trick is in the motions. "Doing motions like swiping or stretching motions will sheer out your foundation and provide a more natural medium coverage finish. Motions like stamping or pressing your brushes into the skin will help build coverage in layers providing more of a full-coverage finish," says Wolborsky. The goal of liquid foundation (and any foundation for that matter) is to create an even, natural-looking complexion. As such, it's important to pick a foundation that matches your undertones. If you have a warm complexion, go with a shade that has yellow undertones, and if your complexion is on the cool side, a foundation with pink undertones is your best bet. To determine your undertones, simply look at the inside of your wrist. If your veins look green, you likely have warm undertones; if they look blue, your undertones are cool. Makeup artist Tara Lauren has another simple way of identifying them. "Identifying your undertone can be done by taking a look at the skin. If you are picking up hues of reds and orange you are warm. When picking up more blue or pink, you are cool." Simple as that! One of the biggest complaints with liquid foundation is just how easy it is to accidentally create a cakey appearance. While our testers found that all six of our favorite liquid foundations applied smoothly, it's still worthwhile to learn how to prevent liquid foundation from caking. "The best way to prevent liquid foundation from caking is to apply it to hydrated skin. This can be achieved by using a hydrating moisturizer or primer with a similar base as the foundation," says Lauren. And, most makeup artists agree that hydrated skin is the key to avoiding a cakey look. For that extra step to avoid caking, prime and set your skin accordingly. A quality primer will smooth out the finish of your skin so that liquid foundation won't cake into your pores and creases. Once primed, apply your liquid foundation and set it with a translucent powder or facial setting spray to keep it from melting into fine lines during the day. Mature or especially dry skin can benefit from using a moisturizing foundation made for mature skin to prevent caking. Chaise Sanders is a freelance beauty, fashion, and lifestyle editor.
